CASE STUDY #14 PaSea H.EL.M.E.T. Marine Risk Assessment

RISK ELEMENT: Life Rafts & Launching Appliances

MRA FINDING: The Embarkation Ladder for the forward life raft was found to be in very poor condition

REF. SOLAS II-1/3-9, III/13.4-6, LSA IV/4.1-3

THE PROPER CONDITION OF THE LIFE-SAVING & ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT IS VITAL SINCE IT ENSURES THE CREW'S SAFETY & SURVIVAL IN AN EMERGENCY SITUATION.

THE EMBARKATION LADDER NEEDS TO BE REPLACED THE SOONEST POSSIBLE. THE CONDITION OF LIFE-SAVING EQUIPMENT NEEDS TO BE CHECKED REGULARLY.

ADDITIONALLY, THE CREW'S AWARENES REGARDING SAFETY ISSUES HAS TO BE ENSURED.
